‘King Komodo’

Project Summary

Logline: ‘King Komodo’ is a classic creature feature with all the action, intrigue, adventure and romance of the other timeless feature films in this genre, from ‘Beauty and The Beast’ right up to ‘The Shape of Water’. The centerpiece of this film is Indonesia’s own most notorious, feared, misunderstood beast: the Komodo Dragon. It’s a bit like ‘Jurassic Park’ meets ‘Mighty Joe Young.’

In the Komodo Islands of Indonesia, an Australian Zoologist, Emily Crooms is given a ‘Komodo Dragon’ egg by an Anthropologist, Jack Sinclair, who had discovered this rather conspicuously large egg while on a scuba diving expedition near the 5,000-year-old underwater Buddhist/Hindu Temple Garden of Pemuteran, off the coast of Bali. Three weeks later, the egg has hatched into a very strong and handsome yet very ferocious looking ‘Komodo Dragon’. When the Komodo Dragon reaches its full size in a remarkably short time the world’s scientific community starts to get curious and scientists from various disciplines start to arrive at the ‘Komodo Sanctuary and national Park to have a look.

Jack’s discovery of the deep fault line and uplift of the Tectonic Plates gets the attention of the (newly formed and secret) US Dept of Weaponized Geology. The Komodo National Park due to increase rush of scientific expeditions and excited Tourist was forced to restrict visits to the park to only those with a special Government visa. DWG has long suspected that North Korea’s nuclear test was far more powerful than North Korean government claimed. A new analysis of the 2017 test reveals it had an explosive yield of approximately 250 kilotons, or about fifteen times greater than the atomic bomb dropped on Hiroshima. The new estimate is dramatically bigger than previous North Korean nuclear tests, lending credence to claims that a thermonuclear device was tested. The DWG interrogate and forcibly employ Jack Sinclair to take them to the site of where he found the large Komodo Dragon egg. Core samples and Carbon Dating suggest that the uplift of the strata and fissure of the Tectonic plate may reveal that Nuclear test done by Korean have unearthed a piece of the Earth’s Crust that was buried for 40,000 years or more and there is suspicion that there is seepage of Radioactive Waste that may cause serious threat to both Marine and Human Life causing Divers to dive with special Radioactive Retardant Suits. North Korean organizes an expedition to the Komodo Islands ostensibly to try to acquire a Komodo Dragon for their National Zoo yet they not only have an eye on Emily’s particular Komodo: the covertly conspire to explore the disrupted Tectonic plate where Jack found the large Komodo Dragon Egg.

As the Komodo Dragon reached an unprecedented length of 27 feet animal, Emily and the Zoo Staff need Military Support to stop the men that intended to steal or even kill her Komodo Dragon. Many try to con Emily and her associates at the Komodo National Park with promises of money and fame and even an offer to personally bring ‘King’ her giant Komodo to famous Zoos in America, Europe or even Dubai. Soon she realizes that she must escape by night and hide ‘King’ in a remote Cave in the Mountains before she is killed and ‘King’ is taken away by those of evil motives. Emily’s dreams for ‘King’ become a nightmare forcing her in a panic to flee. However, her plans go wrong as she is ambushed and her ‘King Komodo’ destroys the would-be poachers and wrecks several vehicles and buildings. ‘King Komodo’ is sentenced by the corrupt courts and ordered to be killed by Lethal Injection. Will Emily, Jack and the Komodo National Park Service be able to save ‘King Komodo’? You will just have to read the script (or see the movie) to find out!
