

ORDINANCE NO. 386

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 35 OF ORDINANCE NO. 317 REGULATING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA, That Section 35 of Ordinance No. 317, Alcoholic Beverages, be in all things repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

"Section 35. Sunday Alcoholic Beverage Permit."

Upon application, the City of Rolla may issue a Sunday alcoholic beverage permit to an alcoholic beverage licensee licensed under City of Rolla Ordinance No. 317, Sale of Alcoholic Beverages. The authority to issue such permits rests solely with the Rolla City Council and may be issued only if the following requirements are met:

1. Any licensee desiring a Sunday permit shall make proper application to the City of Rolla on an application form provided by the City.

2. The application must be accompanied by payment of the fee required by the license applied for. Fees accompanying the permit application shall be as follows:

a) \$200 if the application requests permission to sell alcoholic beverages on Sundays for one year.

b) \$25 per Sunday, to a maximum of \$200, for each Sunday on which the applicant requests to sell alcoholic beverages.

3. The application shall indicate if the applicant is requesting permission to sell alcoholic beverages only or if the applicant is also asking for permission to allow dancing on the licensed premises on the Sundays applied for.

4. The hours of sale and dancing may be between 12 noon Sunday and 1 A.M. on Monday. The permit issued, if any, shall designate the hours.

5. The licensee shall enforce the requirement of this Ordinance.

6. All permits expire June 30 of each year regardless of the date of issuance.


THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS FINAL
