ORDINANCE 505

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolla, North Dakota, that Rolla Municipal Code Chapter 2.10 CITY COUNCIL STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE be created as follows:

Chapter 2.10 CITY COUNCIL STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE

Sections:

2.10.010 Position created.

Hereby created is the position of student representative as a nonvoting, advisory ex-officio representative on the City Council of the City of Rolla. The student representative shall be a high school age student residing in the City of Rolla and will serve as a liaison between the City and matters related to youth in the community.

2.10.020 Appointment.

Students wishing to serve shall make application through the Mayor for a student representative. Appointments shall be by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the City Council.

2.10.030 Duties and responsibilities.

A. The student representative shall be seated with the City Council and encouraged to participate in discussions on issues before the Council.

B. The student representative will receive an agenda for each regular and special Council meeting, except meetings solely devoted to an executive session. The student representative will receive a copy of all notices of public hearings deemed by the City Auditor to be directly related to interests or activities of youth and students in the community. Should these disclose issues that directly impact and involve students or youth in the community, the student representative will be encouraged to participate at the meeting or hearing to the same extent and same fashion as members of the public.

C. The student representative shall be governed by and comply with all the provisions of the Rolla Municipal Code.

D. The student representative shall not attend executive sessions or closed sessions of the City Council unless invited to attend by the City Council.

E. The student representative shall not be able to cast a vote on any motions before the City Council.

2.10.040 Term of office.

The student representative shall serve a one-year term.

2.10.050 Parental Consent

Student representatives must present a Parental Consent form signed by a parent or legal guardian. The Parental Consent form and a copy of this Ordinance shall be provided to all student representatives after appointment by the Mayor and approval by City Council. The form must be turned into City Hall before the student representative begins their position.
