Studio Policies | 2026-2027 Season

We want our studio policies to be simple and easy to understand. Please review and acknowledge each section before completing registration.

1. TUITION & FEES

Performance Group

- Performance Group tuition is based on the full dance season, not the number of classes held in a particular month. Tuition is divided into 10 payments for convenience.
- The first payment is due at registration. The remaining 9 payments are due on the 1st of each month, October-June.
- Tuition includes a guaranteed 32 classes, recital costume/tights/accessories, recital t-shirt, medal, and digital download of the recital.
- Students who enroll after the season has started will have their tuition adjusted based on their enrollment date and the remaining portion of the season.
- A \$30 annual registration fee is due at registration and covers the August-July dance year.
- A \$20 late fee will be added to accounts with a past-due balance on the 11th of the month.
- Tuition and registration fees already paid are non-refundable. Tuition is not prorated for individual missed classes.
- All account balances must be paid in full for a dancer to participate in the recital.

Seasonal Sessions

- Seasonal Session tuition is due in full at registration and is non-refundable.
- Seasonal Sessions are guaranteed the number of classes advertised at registration.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT: I understand that Performance Group tuition is for the full season and is divided into monthly payments for convenience. I have reviewed and agree to the Tuition & Fees Policy.

2. WITHDRAWAL POLICY

We understand that sometimes a class or program may not be the right fit.

- All withdrawals must be submitted in writing by email. A dancer is considered enrolled and tuition will continue to be charged until DDF receives written withdrawal notice. Stopping attendance does not automatically withdraw a dancer from class.
- New students have 30 days from their first class to decide if the Performance Group is the right fit. If you email DDF to withdraw within those 30 days, there will be no future tuition charges. Tuition and fees already paid are non-refundable.
- After the first 30 days, withdrawal notices received before the 15th of the month will stop future tuition payments.
- Withdrawal notices received on or after the 15th will result in the following month's payment being charged as the final payment.
- Withdrawals after January 31 will be charged a \$50 costume return fee for each Performance Group class, as recital costumes have already been ordered at this point in the season.
- Seasonal Session tuition is non-refundable.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT: I understand that all withdrawals must be submitted by email and that stopping attendance does not cancel my dancer's enrollment or tuition obligation. I understand the withdrawal deadlines and costume return fee described above.

3. CLASSES, CANCELLATIONS & ATTENDANCE

- Performance Group classes are guaranteed 32 classes during the season. Seasonal Sessions are guaranteed the number of classes advertised.
- Studio closures for holidays, weather, or other circumstances do not automatically result in a make-up class. A make-up will be scheduled if necessary to meet the guaranteed number of classes.
- DDF may combine or reschedule classes and may provide a substitute or replacement teacher when necessary.
- Cancellation information will be communicated by email.
- Regular attendance is important, especially as recital choreography begins.
- Dancers who miss more than 2 of the final 8 classes before recital may be removed from portions of the routine or from the performance at the teacher/director's discretion.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT: I understand DDF's class guarantee, cancellation and attendance policies, including the importance of attendance leading up to the recital.

4. DRESS CODE & CLASS EXPECTATIONS

- Dancers are expected to follow the dress code for their registered class. Current dress code requirements are available on our website.
- Dance shoes must be clean, in good condition, and used for indoor dance classes only.
- Street shoes are not permitted on the dance floors, including for Hip Hop.
- Jewelry should be removed when necessary for dancer safety.
- Students are expected to arrive ready to participate, treat teachers and classmates respectfully, and follow teacher instructions.
- Continued failure to follow the dress code or classroom expectations may result in the dancer being asked to observe class.

5. PHOTO & VIDEO POLICY

Dynamic Dance & Fitness may take photographs and videos during classes, performances, studio events, and other DDF activities. Images and videos may be used on the DDF website, social media, advertisements, and other studio promotional materials.

A dancer's full name or other identifying personal information will not be included without additional permission.

If you do not want your child photographed or recorded for promotional purposes, you must submit your request in writing by email to DDF. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to notify the studio of this preference and any future changes in writing.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT: I have read and understand DDF's Photo & Video Policy, including how to opt my child out of photography and video used for promotional purposes.

6. PRIVATE LESSON CANCELLATION POLICY

- Private lessons require at least 24 hours' notice for cancellation.
- Lessons canceled with at least 24 hours' notice may be rescheduled or credited.
- No-shows or lessons canceled with less than 24 hours' notice will be charged and are not eligible for a make-up or credit.
