So, what are some of the kinds of good stuff they do there? Fitness, dance, and wellness classes, pool, ping pong, puzzles and games, and a daily nutritious lunch for \$4.00. There are afternoon movies and Bingo, a Thursday afternoon dance with live music, bean bag baseball, Reader's Club, Writers Workshop, a group for creative crafters that meets every Monday---and that's not all.
