COVID BOOSTER VACCINATIONS:

Residents throughout the Bailiwick in the over 50 years/frontline & care workers and vulnerable categories will be offered a covid vaccine booster.

Residents in these categories who have received the initial 2 covid vaccinations will be offered a booster no earlier than 6 months after the second vaccination of the primary course.

The surgery will contact you with an appointment. If you received your vaccinations off island, then you must email the surgery practice.manager@sarkmedical.co.uk if you wish to receive a booster as you will not be on our database.

'FLU VACCINATIONS:

Influenza vaccines will be available from the surgery to all children under the age of 16 years, free of charge. All other residents will be offered the vaccination at a cost of £10.

The Committee would encourage all residents to take up this offer.

Influenza, whilst a regular seasonal illness, can cause serious illness and complications which may be life threatening for vulnerable people.
