8-Jul-25	<p>Couched Applique-as-You-Quilt</p> <p>Intermediate Level Domestic and Longarm</p> <p>Telene loves a quick and easy project. This technique is just that! Students will be creating their own mandala type design, then do the applique and quilting together with free motion couching, and then add some more details with free motion quilting. Fun, freeing, no pre-planning, no rules...!</p>	
9-Jul-25	<p>Magical Wholecloths</p> <p>1 Hour lecture</p> <p>We look at the origins of the wholecloth, its presence today and how each quilter can personalize their wholecloth. This presentations contains a lot of examples and inspiration with many works from Telene and other popular quilters.</p> <p>Threads & Things</p> <p>Beginner - Intermediate - Advanced 1-1/2 hour lecture/demo</p> <p>Learn about different threads, weights, needles, tension, stands and nets, couching, bobbin quilting and how to successfully quilt with all of it.</p> <p>Inktense Colour-Me-Whole 1</p> <p>3 hours colouring only Hands-On Any Level - No Stitching</p> <p>Learn to add permanent color to quilted pieces using 3 different methods. A pre-quilted 18" square block will be provided, ready to receive the Intense color. A relaxing class with no stitching as Telene will share her successful methods using Derwert Intense pencils.</p>	  
10-Jul-25	<p>FMQ 101</p> <p>Absolute beginner level Domestic and Longarm</p> <p>A beginner free motion quilting, hands-on class for absolute beginners. Students will be taught HOW to free motion quilt with 3 crucial exercises and then move on to a few basic designs. Luckily, this class will be meander free as there are numerous other, easier designs to create. One student per longarm frame machine will allow for maximum stitching time during this compact 3 hour class with achievable results and a class sample to take home.</p>	
11-Jul-25	<p>Upcycle Bag</p> <p>Any Level Domestic and Longarm</p> <p>Everybody has an old pair or two of jeans in the closet. Maybe they don't fit anymore or maybe they are stained. Upcycling is a wonderful way to create a new item or gift without having to buy a lot of new fabric. Students will upcycle a pair of jeans to make a useful tote bag with fun, free range raw edge applique and free motion quilting all in one on the longarm. Once done, students only have to finish the sides and top edge with binding. Great gifts and usable items that can be personalized without breaking the bank. Join Telene for this fun "let your hair down" class. One student per longarm frame machine will allow for maximum stitching time during this compact 3 hour class with achievable results and a class sample to take home.</p>	
12-Jul-25	<p>Micro/Mini</p> <p>Advanced Level Domestic and Longarm</p> <p>Did you know that custom micro quilting for miniature quilts can be achieved on a longarm machine? Scaling everything down into a miniature quilt can be challenging, especially the custom free motion quilting. Students will learn about the appropriate thread needle and quilting mode to use, best posture and machine settings to apply and how to scale down any design drastically and stitch out successfully where individual stitches are still visible. A great challenge for the more advanced quilter. One student per longarm frame will allow for maximum stitching time during the compact 3 hour class with achievable results and a class sample to take home.</p>

Telene is an avid quilter, designer and free motion quilt teacher from Gauteng, South Africa. She is a Handi Quilter International Ambassador and a South African Quilters Guild Accredited Quilt Teacher. Telene has won numerous prizes for her quilts and has attained Master Quilter Status from the SAQG. She has proudly had quilts on display internationally as well.

Telene's mother taught her to sew when she was young and her obsession with quilting stems from her passion for sewing. She completed a B Tech in Interior Architecture and during her studies, she became involved in her parents' sewing machine dealership where she taught a variety of basic sewing lessons. During her time in the corporate world (2002 – 2010) as an Interior Architect, she started quilting. In January 2011 she began teaching basic quilting classes which developed into quilting for clients, specializing in custom free motion quilting. She has taught at several local as well as international events and is currently teaching virtual classes online from her home.

Her love for design showed with the creation of her own line of whole cloth quilt patterns for free motion quilters. Telene is also a designer for Full Line Stencil Company and Honest Fabrics where her unique designs can be found on versatile stencils and printed fabric panels. Her fabric designs also expanded into a range of custom printed merchandise. Telene's quilt designs are now also available in digital format for computer aided quilters with the masterful digitizing of Mary Beth Krapil.

Free motion quilting is Telene's absolute passion, and she is a firm believer that everybody can quilt. Her goal is to inspire students to simply try, as she knows they will never look back!
