Treated Soybeans: No treated soybeans will be accepted. Subject to charges for contamination of soybean inventory.

Sample Grade: Sample grade shall be soybeans which do not meet the requirements for any of the grades No. 1 to No. 4, inclusive; or which are musty, sour, or heating or which have any commercially objectionable foreign odor, or which stones; or which are otherwise of distinctly low quality.
