Greetings my fellow Sons,

Membership cards have arrived from National.

Thank you for your patience. The Area Vice Commanders have been distributing them to the Squadrons that have submitted their SORF's (Squadron Officer Report Forms) to Detachment. If your Squadron has sent in your forms & not received your cards, please contact you Area Vice Commander or Detachment. We are currently 33rd in the nation & 5th in the Western Region with 9.28% as of the SAL National Membership Report dated September 12th. We are 57 members short of the 10% goal.

We finished the 2022 membership year at 108% as of October. We hit last year's goals, now it is time to turn our attention to the 2023 membership cards with less than two months before the 2022 cards are no longer valid for use at the post.

Let's make our numbers and get new volunteers into the post like we did last year... Keep up the great work!

In August Detachment Officers, including myself & Detachment members attended the 50th SAL National Convention in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The Detachment received 5 awards.

National Commander Michael Fox had the convention dedicated to *Past National Commander Roland Matteson* who was from Arizona & served as National Commander in 93-94. Roland passed away on January 1st, 2022.

I will be attending the Department of Arizona Legion College being held at Post 29 in Glendale, September 16th-18th. The next two Legion College classes will be held January 27th-29th at Post 36 in Tucson & in

April at Post 25 in Cottonwood. If you would like to attend Arizona Legion College, you first have to complete the Basic Training

course that is available through mylegion. org. Then submit an application that

is found on the department's website azlegion.org.


