Cracked Terra



This textile experimentation project explores surface design through a flour resist dyeing technique applied to a cotton dress, resulting in a “broken solid” effect. Using natural dyes—including beet powder, turmeric, spirulina, and matchaThe resist process creates subtle disruptions in color saturation, allowing each pigment to interact uniquely with the fabric and produce rich tonal variation. Rooted in sustainability and material exploration, this piece highlights the expressive potential of natural dyeing while transforming a simple silhouette into a tactile, visually dynamic garment.

I wanted to translate that message into something wearable, so I used a laser cutter to etch the verse directly into the denim, making it a subtle but meaningful detail. The jacket features bold red leather patches on the front and elbows, forming cross shapes that add both symbolism and an edgy contrast against the dark denim. The cropped silhouette keeps it modern and wearable, while still feeling like a statement piece. Overall, this design reflects my desire to merge personal belief with fashion in a way that feels authentic, expressive, and true to my aesthetic.

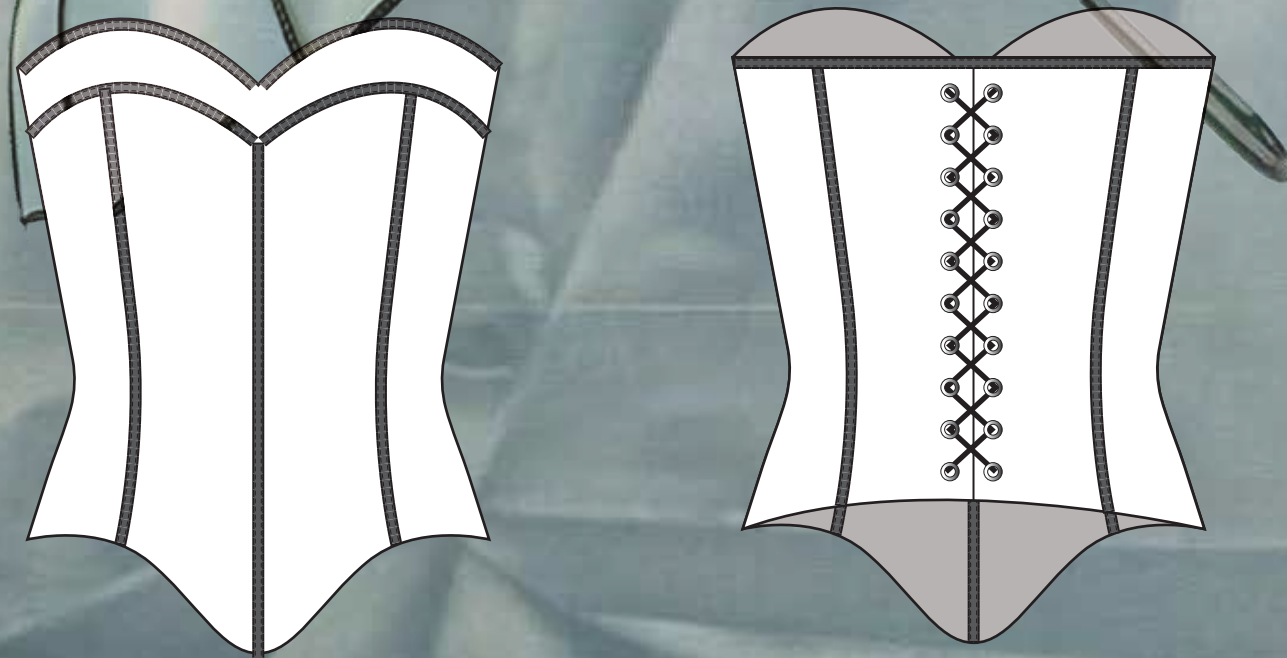
