Rainbow Acres is a Christian community with a heart that empowers adults (Ranchers) with development disabilities to live to their fullest potential with dignity and purpose. The Ranchers all have unique abilities.

Rainbow Acres is anchored in core values of faith, hope, love, and compassion. The Ranchers new milestones, miracles and expanded capabilities are witnessed daily.

Rainbow Acres is sitting on 50 acres. Paul Higgins is the President of this campus that has several buildings. There are 12 homes, each having private bedrooms and a care giver suite. The homes are beautiful.

Ranchers come from across the US and they range from age 18 - 80.

The Ranchers are offered Life skill courses, Social skills, Time Management and Basic Banking. They have hands on experiences in the barn and greenhouse. Professional artists provide classes in sketching, paint colors and creating a finished work of art, making things for their room, gifts and selling them in the gift store. They have the opportunity to weave rugs, wall hangings, scarves, and much more. They also learn how to make mosaics with colored glass. Ranchers also get involved in music like playing a digital piano, other instruments and singing in the choir.

They have a chance of employment on campus, community --- restaurants, grocery stores, churches and many other places. They can also choose to do community volunteering.

This is an amazing place to visit. They welcome anyone to come enjoy a meal with the Ranchers and take in the beauty with a tour. Rainbow Acres is one of our missions for ABC.
