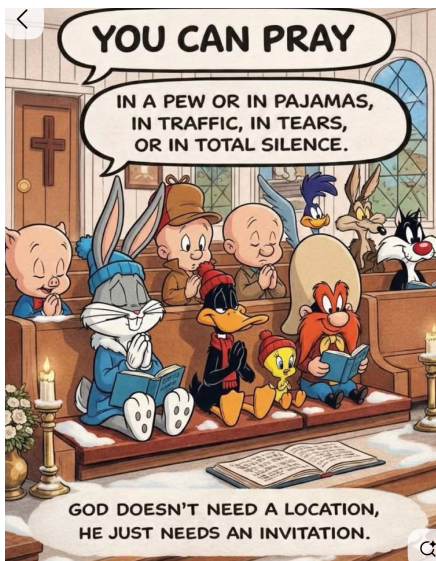

In February, Kristy made a trip to Jordon to visit one of the International Ministries' new partners, Zarga Baptist Church. The church is working in a very difficult area due to challenges facing Syrian refugees and the poor Jordanian population. They have a thriving outpatient medical clinic, trauma counseling groups for women and children, education programs in refugee camps, widow support groups, a coffee shop that students use for a safe study area and so much more.

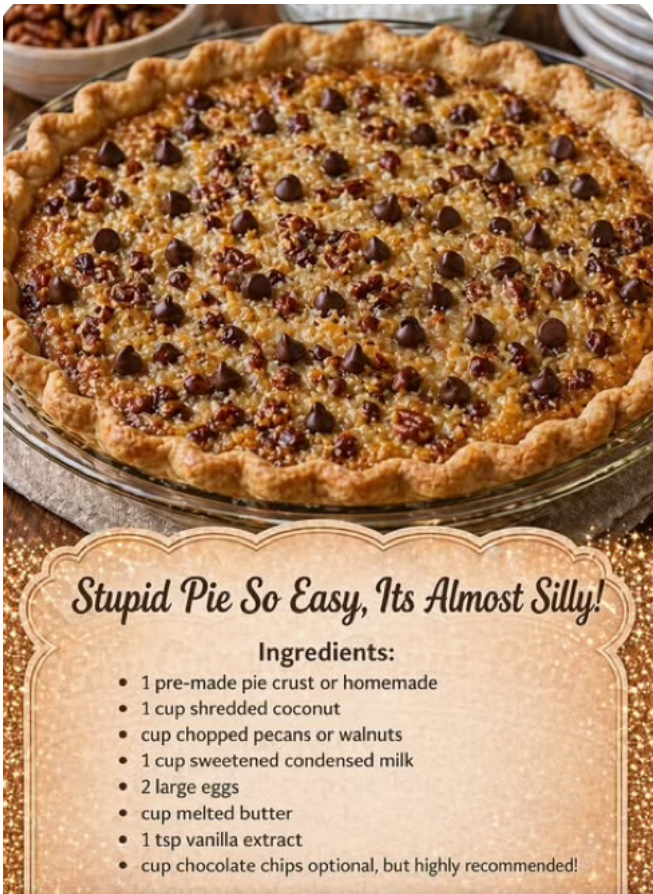
