LEMBKE's of THAILAND

It's been 3 years being in Thailand. Eric and Yuree are grateful for all of the support in prayers and finances. At the Seminary, Yuree has been teaching Thai. She also has had 3 additional classes with about 50 people from the community. Yuree also offers sewing classes, teaching how to make tote bags and side bags. Some advance students are making clothing and teaching others. Yuree says, "All of my students have had to leave their home because of the unsafe situations in Myanmar. There are so many young and vulnerable people facing violence and persecution."

At the seminary, Eric has taught several different classes—information technology, Biblical research and writing, and English reading comprehension. He also teaches how to write papers on writing sermons or Bible studies. Eric also teaches engineering students and they are working on a hydraulic ram pump project. After some testing and expanding the project on building a dam, students learned how to build forms and mix concrete. Eric says, "The lessons learned in this project can be applied to the student's future projects. In the future, they can provide water for a village without the use of electricity."

The Thai government had a request that the foundation send support for 500+ new refugees along the border. The foundation reached out to Eric and Yuree to see if they could help. Through a One Great Hour of Sharing Emergency Grant and International Ministries Award, \$5,000 was provided. Yuree formed a team to prepare 127 sacks for each family.

Harper will be turning 5 August 23. Yuree found a Thai school close to where they live. The school is within walking distance. Although the school is Thai they also teach English. She is speaking mostly English, but understands Karen, Thai, and some Burmese. (I think a 5 year old is doing better than most of us) 😊😊

PRAYER requests:

- Safety and welfare from Burmese military
- Refugees and internally displaced people living with no healthcare
- Food insecurity and recent decreases in aid to the refugees camps
- Doctor of Ministry program launching soon
- Their family as they continue to serve God in the best way possible

APPLEBEE'S ORIENTAL CHICKEN SALAD

- 2 grilled chicken breasts (sliced)
