Standard Deduction Amounts

Filing Status	2025 Standard Deduction
Single	\$15,750
Married Filing Jointly (MFJ)	\$31,500
Married Filing Separately (MFS)	\$15,750
Head of Household (HOH)	\$23,625
Qualifying Surviving Spouse	\$31,500

Additional Standard Deduction (Age 65+ or Blind)

Filing Status	Additional Amount (Per Qualifying Person)
Single / HOH	\$1,600
MFJ / MFS / Surviving Spouse	\$1,300

Combined Standard Deduction (Including 65+ / Blind Add-Ons)

Filing Status	Base Deduction	If One Person Qualifies	If Two Qualify
Single	\$15,750	\$17,350	N/A
Head of Household	\$23,625	\$25,225	N/A
MFJ	\$31,500	\$32,800	\$34,100
MFS	\$15,750	\$17,050	N/A
Surviving Spouse	\$31,500	\$32,800	N/A

Senior Bonus Deduction (2025–2028)

Additional benefit for taxpayers age 65+

Eligibility	Amount
Per qualifying spouse age 65+	+ \$6,000
Phaseout	Reduced by 6% of AGI over \$150,000 (per spouse)

Examples

Scenario	Total Standard Deduction
Single, age 65+	\$15,750 + \$1,600 + \$6,000 = \$23,350
MFJ, both 65+	\$31,500 + \$1,300 + \$1,300 + \$6,000 + \$6,000 = \$46,100
