RMSE Islamic Dress Code Policy

General Guidelines:

- 2. Uniform Description:
 - Girls (Kindergarten to 3rd Grade):

 - Brown khakis

Girls (4th to 6th Grade):

- Option 1: White or navy blue hijab (headscarf).
- Navy blue, light blue or gray long sleeve polo shirt
- Navy blue tunic, or navy blue jumper.
- Brown khakis
- Option 2: Navy blue or black abaya (optional).
- Boys (Kindergarten to 6th Grade):
 - Navy blue, light blue, or gray polo shirts.
 - Brown khakis

Implementation and Compliance:

- **Enforcement:** Teachers and staff will monitor students' adherence to the dress code during school hours and activities.
- **Communication:** The dress code will be communicated to all students, parents/guardians, and school staff at the beginning of each academic year.
- Disciplinary Action: Non-compliance with the dress code may result in counseling and reminders for younger students, while older students may face disciplinary measures in line with school policies.
