Rules:

1. Course is timed and assessed faults.
2. Objective is to get through as quickly and correctly as possible, as well as SAFELY.
3. Faults will be explained during walk through dependent upon the obstacle.
DO NOT MISS THE WALK THROUGH.
4. The competitor has 10 mins to finish course; an 8 min warning will be given.
5. If the judge(s) asks/ask the competitor to move on from the obstacle, competitor must move on to next obstacle or competitor will be excused and given a 0.
6. The judge(s) has/have the final ruling on penalties and other issues that arise.
7. A faster time WITH faults CANNOT place higher than a slower time WITHOUT faults. In other words, if you have the fastest time but 3 faults and another competitor has a slower time with 0 faults, that competitor will place above you. You are still eligible to place and will place according to where you fall within the time/fault combo. See rules sheet for scoring examples.

A parent or legal guardian must be present on the rodeo/arena grounds with a rider/contestant 17 years or younger. If there is not a parent or legal guardian present, the youth will not be allowed to ride.
