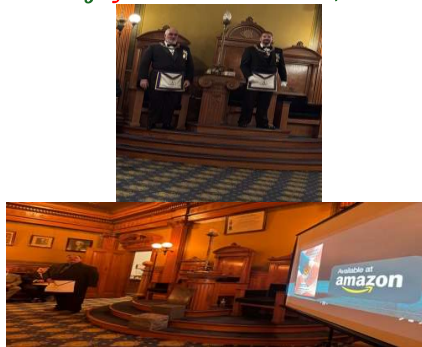


### 19th District Highlights

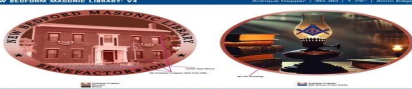
