



**BROTHER BLACKMAN VISITS R.\*.L.\*.127, ANTRODEQUENTAL LODGE IN SAINT MARIA PORTAGUEL**

For those of your who don't know Brother Blackman. He's a long-time brother who was raised in Pythagorean Lodge on December 13<sup>th</sup>, 1994. After some time away from the craft Dean has returned with a vengeance as the Junior Deacon of George H. Taber Lodge in Fairhaven Mass. Dean is huge into the Esoteric teachings of the bible and freemasonry alike. This recent trip has only enlightened him more into the teachings of this study.

Q: Brother Blackman, I understand you visited Portugal recently on vacation. What area did you visit?

A: We visited the Azores. More specifically Saint Maria island.

Q: How is freemasonry viewed in Portugal? Is it the same as the US?

A: Up until 50 years ago you would be put in prison or even killed if you were found out to be a brother. Nowadays, you will be exposit from your Church, you could lose your job and your reputation would be ruined.

Q: How did you prepare to visit a lodge in Saint Maria?

A: I called the Grand Lodge of Massachusetts and got traveling papers prior to my trip. I also asked if our Grand Lodge would contact their Grand Lodge to help me make a contact.

Q: How were you tried before gaining admission to the lodge?

A: I was given a contact through our Grand Lodge. I spoke to him, and he told me that we would have to meet prior to meeting. This brother was the Worshipful Master of the lodge, and he wanted me to sit down, meet his family and have coffee with him prior to visiting the lodge. This was mostly to go over the ground rules. The do's and Don'ts of Masonry in his country. They take secrecy very seriously.

Q: Where was the lodge? Please describe the building it was in.

A: The lodge was out in the countryside in the middle of an abandon industrial park. This was nothing like lodges in our country. There was no parking lot. The building consisted of one room about 20'X20'.

Q: Is Visiting a lodge in Portugal the same as visiting a lodge in the states?

A: No not at all! Everyone came to this hidden building off the beating path. They came in their normal clothing and changing in lodge. This is customary so no one where they meet. Many brothers traveled over an hour to meet in this lodge.

Q: How were you received?

A: Everyone was excited to have a visited from the US. There was one picture taken of us and if you ask me, I might show it to you.

This was a beautiful experience and shows me that Masonry is not excepted or allowed everywhere. If someone found out to be a freemason, you would be excommunicated from the community. This is life and death to, and we should be happy that we can practice that we don't have to hide this life from others in our country. I want to take Brother Blackman for sharing his for sharing his Traveling Man story with us.
