

## Little Thicket Nature Sanctuary Rules and Regulations

- 1. Please leave the Sanctuary just as you find it. All flora and fauna are protected and must be left for others to enjoy.
- 2. Overnight camping is permitted. If camping outside the Cove, use only cook stoves.
- 3. Please carry all your litter home with you. Leave no trace.
- 4. NO HUNTING ALLOWED! Exceptions must be approved by the Sanctuary Committee.
- 5. Collecting is not authorized except for research and education in the study and identification of plants, mushrooms, insects or other natural or man-made elements found at the sanctuary.
- 6. Pets are allowed on a leash only. Please clean up after your pet.
- 7. Notify Mike Zuchowski (214) 288-9383, or any Sanctuary Committee member, of any vandalism or unauthorized use of the Sanctuary.
- 8. Remember to lock the gate when you leave. Please reset the combination to all zeros.
- CAUTION WITH FIRES: Open campfires in the Cove allowed in existing fire pits only.
   Make sure no burn ban is in effect in San Jacinto County. No smoking is allowed in the Sanctuary.
