Brief History

I am from Kyauk Pan Du village of Maungdaw township. I am the 3rd son among 5 siblings. The other siblings are:

- (1) Alla Putu
- (2) Lawspita Khatu
- (3) Kalar Myar (dead)
- (4) Mawlazan Khatu (dead)

I have no education. I work as a daily labor. I am married to Nru Bar, daughter of (F) No Ra Mauk, (M) Arbani. We have 8 children.

Claims

How I Was Recruited:

There is a mosque in our village and I went there to pray, we had to go 5 times a day. Sometimes when we were in the mosque to pray, Mawlawi [Imam] Khaw Li Ron told us villagers that someday soon ARSA would attack the security forces and occupy the region, and make it an Islamic State. Mawlawi Khaw Li Ron told us that we have been oppressed in education, social affairs and religion, and that we had to attack, and take this land. He said the attacks would start after ARSA terrorists and trainees arrived from Bangladesh, and that they would bring guns and bombs. He told us that we need to get ready. This was what he used to tell us very often.

How We Prepared to Attack:

At 9:00 pm on 24.8.2017, Mawlawi Khawli Ron gathered the villagers at the mosque and said that ARSA was going to attack the police outposts in the early morning, and that they would seize the weapons from the outposts. He said ARSA would bring guns and bombs to use for the attacks, and that they would also attack other targets in Maungdaw and Buthidaung Townships.

He told us to gather at the mosque at 12:00 midnight, and if we did not join, we would be killed as traitors. If we were arrested, he told us not to disclose any information about ARSA, and if we did, they would kill our family members. After that, I went home and grabbed my sword, and returned to the mosque. Hama Raza (60), Ali Ar Mauk (30), Boli (60), Boni Myar (70) also came to the mosque with weapons.

Around 12:00 midnight, Mawlawi Khaw Li Ron led us and on the way we saw Rawfique Ullah, Anar Dulla, Zu Bie, Adu Nawbi, Annan Mulla, Zaw Baw, and Habi Ullah with some unknown Mawlawis. Altogether our group numbered around 300 Bengalis.

How We Attacked Gwa Sone Police Outpost:

Around 4:00 am on 25.8.2017, the group, including me, attacked the Gwa Sone Police Outpost. ARSA militants attacked with bombs and guns. When policemen shot back at us we retreated.

How We Were Captured:

We were afraid to go back to our village, and while we were hiding out together with Rawfique Ullah, Anar Dulla, Zu Bie, Adu Naw Bi, Anan Mulla, Zaw Baw and Habi Ullah near Do Tan Village (besides Alay Than Kyaw Village), we were caught and arrested by the Army and BGP (Border Guard Police).
