- That they will be of breeding quality, including temperament and that the owner has endeavoured to obtain its championship or another CKC/AKC title.

If we have a current litter due or on the ground and you are committed to a new puppy or dog to join your family, we will require a \$500.00 non-refundable deposit once your questionnaire is

accepted. This assures us of your commitment and that you are ready and have seriously
thought about a new member joining your family. If, for any reason, there is not a puppy
available from the litter, then the deposit will be returned to you.
