Day 1 Sun. Sept 4 <sup>th</sup>	INTL. FLIGHT	Toronto to Tel Aviv 13:30, LY030 EL AL Airlines (overnight flight).
Day 2 Mon. Sept 5 <sup>th</sup>	TEL AVIV 2 nights in Tel Aviv.	Arrival in Israel 7:10. For those arriving from Toronto, this will become a free day to rest and perhaps visit the beach across from the hotel.
Day 3 Tues. Sept 6 <sup>th</sup> TOUR STARTS!	SOUTH WEST	The Prophet Jonah and the Apostle Peter will come to life for us in <b>Joppa</b> . What similarities were there between these two faithful servants of Jehovah? From there we will head south to <b>Ashkelon*</b> and learn about Samson and the Philistines. A highlight of the day will be <b>Beersheba</b> . Here we will explore the life of the Patriarchs and stand in awe of the ruins left for us to see. How does this location prove that Abraham existed? How does Jehovah look out for the depressed? Beersheba will mean more to you by the end of our time here. On the way back to the hotel, we will make a stop at <b>Tel Lachish</b> where Sennacherib, King of Assyria, was encamped. Where did the 185,000 Assyrians get slaughtered? What can we learn from the Lachish letters? This epic day will conclude as we relive the battle between David and Goliath in the <b>Valley of Elah!</b>
Day 4 Wed. Sept 7 <sup>th</sup>	NORTH WEST 2 nights in Galilee.	Our first stop is the Roman capital city of Judea, <b>Caesarea</b> ! You will be impressed with how well preserved the site is. This will be our first introduction to Herod the great and Pontius Pilot. Learn about the start of Christianty, and meditate on the accounts involving Peter, Cornelius, Philip, and Paul. Later in the morning, we will enjoy a breathtaking view of the Mediterranean Sea and the Kishon Valley from the top of <b>Mt. Carmel.</b> You will feel chills considering Elijah's contest with the Baal prophets, and the fire from heaven! Our afternoon begins at <b>Megiddo</b> , where we will see firsthand what life was like during the time of the Kings of Israel. Look out for evidence from King Solomon's reign! Our day will end with a moving discussion of the life of young Jesus? The adventure continues as we see the sea of Galilee for the first time!
Day 5 Thurs. Sept 8 <sup>th</sup>	NORTH	Have you ever wanted to sit in the area where Jesus gave the sermon on the mount? You will get your chance at <b>Mt. of Beatitudes</b> overlooking the sea of Galilee, where we will consider an abbreviated Watchtower study. The next stop, <b>Caesarea Philippi</b> will delight us as we see how lush and well watered the north of Israel is. We will recall the historic discussion between Jesus and his Apostles, followed by a divine event! <b>Tel Dan</b> will be a key highlight of our trip because of a fascinating detail provided by Moses. Look out for this! Here you will be blown away by the landscape, discovery of an altar from the time of the Kings of Israel, and special ruins from the Patriarchal era. From the source of the Jordan river we make our way back south to Jesus' home base during his ministry, <b>Capernaum</b> . We will walk through the ancient town, and enter the ruins of the synagogue. Following a visit to the <b>Boat Museum</b> , we will have a memorable experience riding a boat on the <b>Sea of Galilee</b> . Our journey will start from the northern shores of Galilee to Tiberius in the west. What a day with the Messiah this will be!
Day 6 Fri. Sept 9 <sup>th</sup>	NORTH EAST 9 nights in Jerusalem.	Our day journeying south will not disappoint. Starting with the special site of <b>Magdala</b> , and visiting a syna- gogue which we can say with great confidence was visited by Jesus himself! You will have your opportunity to imitate Judge Gideon's men in lapping up the water at the spring of <b>Ein Harod</b> . Our trip includes a stop at <b>Beth-Shean</b> , one of the cities of the Decapolis. There are not enough words to describe all the wonderful things we will explore, including a hike and a spectacular view of the Jordan Valley. Reliving the death of Jezebel and imagining Jehu on his chariot will become possible when stopping at <b>Tel Jezreel*</b> . Driving further south fol- lowing the Jordan river we pass through ancient <b>Jericho*</b> . Consider the faith of Judge Joshua and Bartimaeus. Day 8 Sun. Sept 11 <sup>th</sup>		Before diving deep into the city of Jerusalem, we believe in good orientation! The <b>Israel Museum</b> is a wonderful place to start. We will begin with a fascinating examination of the scale model of Jerusalem and its temple from the first century. This will be a great opportunity to identify where key Biblical events took place and better prepare your mind for the walk we will take the following day. At the Israel Museum, you will be impressed with the countless artifacts and impressive finds from sites we visited in the South and North regions. Of course we cannot forget the historic discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls! You will have plenty of time to explore the treasures that interest you. After lunch in <b>Bethlehem</b> we will make our way to the <b>Tower of David Museum*</b> on the western side of the old city of Jerusalem. This museum helps you gain an overview of the history of Jerusalem in chronological order. By the end of the day you will be ready to discover the city in-person!
Day 9 Mon. Sept 12 <sup>th</sup>	JERUSALEM	Our walking tour of Jerusalem must start from the top of the <b>Mt. of Olives</b> . We will take in the view of the old city and ponder Jesus' prophecy of the last days, his confidential discussion with his Apostles, and his ascension to heaven. When we walk down through the <b>Garden of Gethsemane</b> , you will feel the emotion from the night of Nisan 14 and meditate on Jesus' prayer, visit from his angelic brothers, and arrest. The walk through the <b>Kidron Valley</b> will give us a special opportunity to discuss a fascinating account of Abraham and make some faith strengthening connections in regards to Jehovah's eternal purpose. For the first time you will feel the inspiring weight of the temple platform built on the bedrock of Mt. Moriah. As we walk up to <b>Mt. Zion</b> and the old city of David, we will have the opportunity to visit the <b>Davidson Centre</b> . The types and antitypes discussed by the Apostle Paul in Hebrews will be of great interest here. You will be impressed with the <b>Wohl Museum of Archeology*</b> , which includes houses of Levite priests burned from Jerusalem's destruction by the Romans. You will walk underground beneath modern Jerusalem through the <b>Kotel Western Wall Tunnels*</b> , beside the original colossal stones of the temple platform foundation. The pool of <b>Bethesda</b> will be a final stop in the northern part of the old city where we will consider another miracle performed by Jesus.
Day 11 Wed. Sept 14 <sup>th</sup>	CENTRAL	After a comprehensive tour of Jerusalem, we make a trip on the Patriarchal highway. Our first location is <b>an-</b> <b>cient Shiloh</b> , the location of the Tabernacle! After our tour we will consider an abbreviated Watchtower study, and hear some of your personal comments on your highlights of the trip. Driving through Samaria we will reach the top of <b>Mt. Gerizim</b> with an awesome view of Mt. Ebal, Shechem, and Sychar. There will be much to contemplate here. From Abraham, Jacob, Joseph, Joshua, Rehoboam, and more After seeing the traditional location of <b>Jacob's Well*</b> and discussing Jesus' visit with the Samaritan woman, we make our way to <b>Sebastia</b> <b>National Park</b> . Here we learn more about Jezebel's family and the Assyrian conquest of Samaria. The day ends with a fascinating account of Jonathan. What is the connection between Michmash and World War 1? We will discuss this from our look-out at <b>Geva Binyamin</b> .

Day 13 Fri. Sept 16 <sup>th</sup>	SOUTH EAST	How would you conclude your tour of the promised land? Just when you think you have seen enough, we make our way south east through the wilderness of Judah. We must not forget Jesus' 40 days here, and his interaction with Satan. Our first stop is the famous and intimidating fortress of <b>Masada</b> , built by Herod the great. After an exciting ride on the cable car, we make our way to the springs, waterfalls, and pools of <b>Ein Gedi</b> . This refreshing visit will introduce us to the rock badger and mountain goats. We will consider the life of David during his years as a fugitive. Our trip to Israel could not exclude the desert caves of <b>Qumran</b> . There, the precious Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden in humble earthenware vessels. Why was the timing of this discovery of great importance in our modern theocratic history? In the shade away from the dry desert heat, we will briefly discuss the history of God's Word! We will contemplate Moses' life as we view Mt. Nebo across from Qumran. We will then enjoy the long-awaited soak in the mineral-rich <b>Dead Sea</b> (Salt Sea). As we end our vacation, our final stop must be <b>Mt. Scopus</b> .
