# DOCTRINAL BELIEFS

## THE HOLY SCRIPTURES

We believe the Holy Scriptures, consisting of the 66 books of the Old and New Testaments, are the inspired Word of God. The Bible is the final authority for all Christian faith and life, completely trustworthy, without error in the original writings, and sufficient for all matters of faith and conduct.

## THE TRIUNE GOD

We believe in one God, eternally existing in three coequal Persons: Father, Son (Jesus Christ), and Holy Spirit. God is the Creator of all things, infinite in power, knowledge, and love, and is holy and just.

## JESUS CHRIST

We believe Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God, who became truly man without ceasing to be truly God. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, and offered Himself as a sacrifice for sins. He was physically resurrected and ascended to the Father.

# DOCTRINAL BELIEFS

## THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a divine Person, coequal with the Father and the Son, who indwells all believers at salvation. His ministry is to glorify Christ, convict the world of sin, and empower believers for holiness and service.

## HUMANITY AND SIN

We believe that man was created by God in His image, but through Adam's sin, all humanity inherited a sinful nature and became separated from God. All are sinners by nature and choice, deserving judgment, unable to save themselves.

## SALVATION

We believe salvation is a gift of God, received by grace alone through faith alone in Jesus Christ alone (Ephesians 2:8-9). Justification declares the believer righteous; sanctification is the lifelong process of becoming more like Christ.



# THE CHURCH AND FUTURE THINGS
