



How to check End-of-Semester hours with Western Arkansas Apprenticeship via NWACC Workday

1. To view your class hours status as of the end of a semester for Western Arkansas Apprenticeship, please navigate to the following link: <https://www.myworkday.com/nwacc>
2. This will prompt you to log in to the NWACC system.
