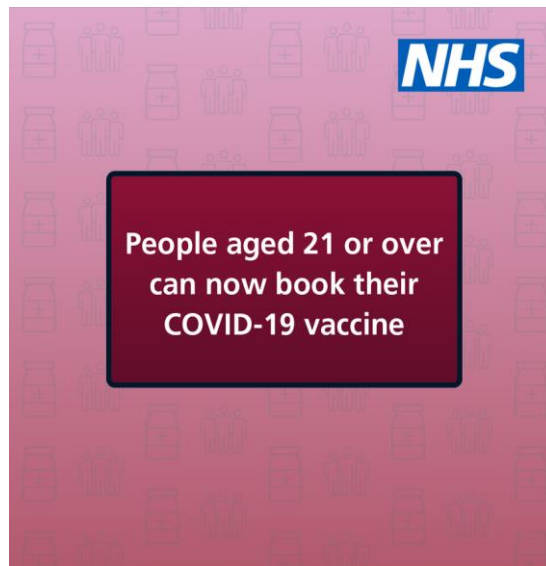




## **Vaccines for the people aged 18 or over**

A distressed resident suggested that HARP remove the shed placed in the front garden at HARPS Bradbury Centre and relocate it to the back garden at this property, this shed could then provide a space for spare mattresses to be stored out of sight until Veolia pick up date.

Enquiries with Veolia suggest that it is not possible to book recurring slots so that HARP could align clear outs dates with Veolia pickup dates.

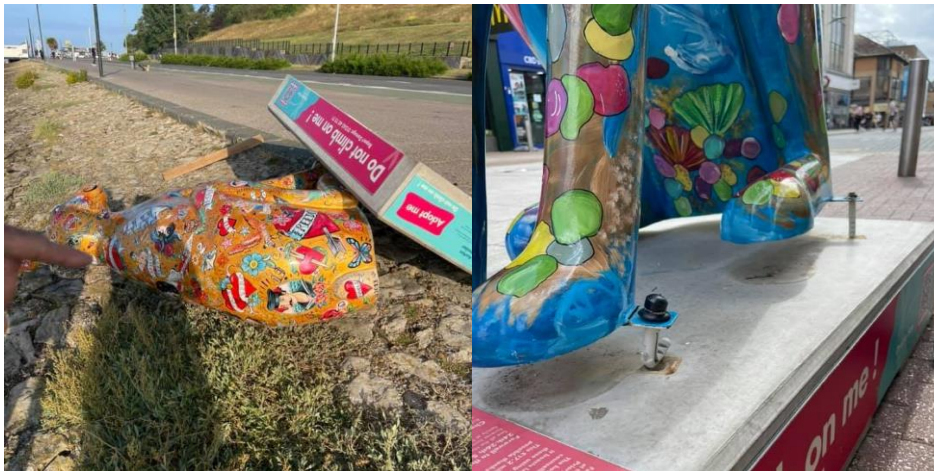
