MESSAGE: "Faith Over Fear"

Have you ever noticed how Halloween is the one night of the year when people actually want to be scared?

We decorate our houses with ghosts and skeletons, hang fake cobwebs on the porch, and carve funny or spooky faces into pumpkins. And what do children do? They dress up, run out into the night, knock on strangers' doors and say, "Trick or treat!"

When you think about it, Halloween is really a night about bravery.

Kids walk in the dark, meet people they don't always know, and collect candy from places that look a little bit scary. But they do it because they trust that behind the masks and decorations, there's something good, kindness, laughter, and maybe even a handful of chocolate.

So, when I got thinking about what I would base my service on this week, well.... Halloween came to mind. Because Halloween can be dark and scary to children and even some adults. Therefore, Halloween reminds us how much we need *light*.

We light up pumpkins, carry flashlights, or hang little glowing decorations. Why? Because the light makes us feel safe, it helps us see what's around us and keeps us from getting lost.

In the Bible, light is a symbol of *God's presence*.

John 1:5 says, "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."

That's a powerful promise! It means that no matter how dark the night gets, whether it's a dark sky or a dark moment in our lives, God's light is still shining.

So let's take that promise a little farther...We all have fears ... not just of ghosts or things that go bump in the night. Sometimes we fear the future. We fear losing people we love. We fear not being enough. But God says, "Do not fear, for I am with you." (Isaiah 41:10) Faith doesn't mean pretending we're never scared.

Faith means we trust that God's light will always guide us through the dark. You see, courage isn't the absence of fear, it's choosing to trust God even when we are afraid. And that's what make us human.

Jesus said, "You are the light of the world." That means every one of us, every heart that believes in God, carries a little bit of that holy light inside. And here's the amazing part: when we shine our light through kindness, forgiveness, and love, it helps others find their way, too. When we smile at someone who's having a bad day, we're shining God's light. When we stand up for what's right, we're shining God's light. When we help, listen, forgive, or encourage, we're shining God's light.

A Little Story "God's Candles"

One evening, a little boy was helping his mom light candles during a power outage. The house was quiet except for the sound of rain tapping against the windows. He watched carefully as his mom lite each candle, first flickering weakly, then glowing steady and bright. After a few moments, the little boy looked up and asked, "Mom, if Jesus is the light of the world, why does He need me to shine too?" His mother smiled softly, her face glowing in the candlelight. "Well," she said, "think about the sun. It's the biggest light of all, bright and powerful, filling the world with warmth. But at night, when the clouds are thick or the rain is heavy, we can't always see it. Does that mean the sun stopped shining?" The boy shook his head. "No, it's still there we just can't see it."

She paused and placed a hand on his shoulder and said ... "You see, sweetheart, there are people who can't see the light of Jesus right now. Maybe they're sad, or scared, or lonely. Maybe life feels too cloudy for them to see the sun. That's why God sends you. You're one of His candles, a little light that can brighten someone's darkness and remind them that God's love is still shining." The boy looked at the flickering candles around the room. They weren't big, but together they filled the whole space with a warm, gentle glow. He smiled and whispered, "Then I'll be a candle for God." And his mom nodded. "That's all God asks ... one light at a time, one heart at a time. When all of us shine together, the darkness doesn't stand a chance."

So on Friday night when the jack-o'-lanterns glowing, houses are creepy and spooky and kids laughing in the dark, remember this:

- Fear is real, but it doesn't define us.
- God's light within us is stronger than any darkness around us.

You don't have to be afraid of the darkness, because God's light lives in you. And when you share that light with others, you help God make the world a little brighter, a little safer, and a lot more loving. Therefore, go ahead and shine your light. Shine it bright and bold for all to see. Because faith will always be stronger than fear, and God's light will always overcome the dark. Amen.
