HOW DO THE TWO ENTITIES PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

By Natchitoches Tribal Registry, LLC: All of your application documents are preserved under the legal authority of NTR and according to acceptable security standards. If you later request to disenroll from the Tribal Registry, only your original submitted documents are returned. However, your information will not be submitted to the B.I.A. for Federal Tribe Recognition Citizenship.

With NTR, your vetted genealogy records remain under legal authority of NTR to be available for vetting of other adult family members who may want to remain enrolled or become enrolled upon reaching adulthood. This information is not shared with the new applicants. Personal information is never put on the internet.

By 501c3 NLT-NC: All of your information which had been submitted by the Natchitoches Tribal Registry to the 501c3 Nonprofit Corporation for volunteer functions will be protected by signed Non-Disclosure Agreements with all Board of Directors and Officers with whom you interact and communicate. If you should request disenrollment, your contact information will be erased from Nonprofit Corporation Records.

Are you a Natchitoches Native American?

Chances are very probable that you are a Natchitoches Indian if you have ancestors that lived in Northwestern Louisiana and surrounding areas whose surnames were: Trichel, Sanchez, Perot, Almond, Dortolon, Desadier, Simon, LeBrun, Meziere, David, DelRio, Rachal, Grappe, Perez, Pardee, Grillet, Winnon, Y"Barbo, Bienville, Braudion, Bynog, Vercher and many others.

Please don't question your relationship if the spelling of names is not exact. Names are all spelled in multiple ways, but the families are still the same. People wrote names by the way that the name sounded to them when spoken. They may have even purposely changed the spelling of their names. There was/is not any law against spelling your name the way that you want to spell it.

The purpose of this process is to identify family members that wish to join our Tribal registry and be included in our application for Federal Recognition. Until we prove our ancestry the Federal Government views us as a group of people working within a non-profit corporation with the goal of acquiring Federal acknowledgement of a Tribal Nation.

Our tribe has obtained Louisiana State recognition and in the future plans to petition the federal government for the same. **Therefore we require you to submit any changes for contact.** Following recognition, more than likely, the process will become more restrictive when it comes to registration.

Here is the process for registration:

1. Every person over 18 must mail in an originally signed registration form as proof of his/her desire to become a member of the tribe.

2. Complete forms for each family parents and their children under the age of 18.

Disabled

children older than 18 will be considered part of this family unit. Grandchildren are not part of a family unit unless approved by chief or vice chief. We do make exceptions for grandparents who are raising their grandchildren and for those who have financial need. If you have questions or are in need of re-consideration of the rules,
Please enclose explanation letter with your application.

3. A copy of each person's birth certificate stating their parent's name must be sent in with the registration packet.
