Action plans will be developed for students to bring about a growing network of certified green schools across the state, to save energy, reduce waste, and improve our health. We want to encourage their leadership as advocates on a wide range of environmental issues, from climate change, social justice, tackling plastic pollution and fostering a culture of zero waste.

The 2022 Summit will again feature keynote speakers and panel discussions, advocacy training, and lots of dialog!

Key organizers include representatives from Plastic Free Delaware, Zero Waste First State, Odyssey Charter School, Green Building United, the Charter School of Wilmington, Delaware Interfaith Power & Light, the Brandywine School District, Newark Charter School, and *student leaders representing high schools from across the state.*
