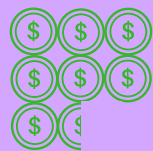

- We rescued 80 at-risk and red-listed dogs from shelters with the majority from Long Beach Animal Care Services (LBACS)!

- Meatloaf, our very special senior bulldog, has struggled to find his place for almost two years. But we never leave a Live Love pup behind. 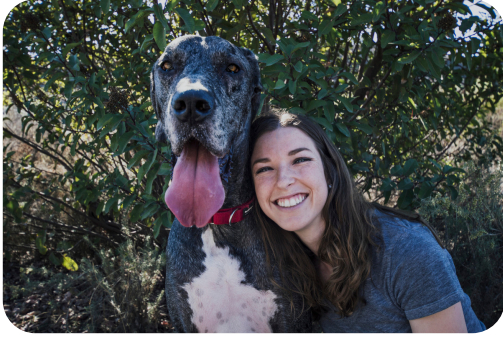
