With that commitment came a need for innovation, increased community engagement and specific life-saving programs that resulted in our greatest year as a rescue family yet. Between Foster the 4th, our shelter dog Community Rescue campaigns, Forever Fosters and the outpouring of support from all of you with each dog we rescued, we put a hashtag to what we knew all along, that #YouAreARescuerToo. You make this impact possible by stepping up to our calls for action. We are all entirely grateful for your support! It is with this spirit of inclusion, generosity, compassion, and dedication that we begin 2020 - welcoming more rescuers than ever to join us as we save lives! #YouAreARescuerToo

♥ Rescue Highlights! ♥

- We had our biggest life-saving impact ever with 203 lives saved. We saved 82 dogs just in July and August with our 2019 Foster the 4th program.
- We continue to make Long Beach Animal Care Services (LBACS), our local city shelter, a priority with 84 of our 98 shelter transfers from LBACS.
- We have a record setting 152 adoptions! This includes special dogs like Juniper, Babycakes, Dulce, Tiny Tim, Amethyst and more.
- We had our gala event, Boats n' Barks, and it was such a huge success! Thank you to our generous sponsors the Karen T. Hilburn Trust, Fremantle Media, our host The Boathouse and all the volunteers and donors that made this a magical and beautiful night celebrating love!
- Forever Fosters are dogs that have special needs or require hospice care. We could not help these angels-in-waiting without the amazing Forever Foster families that make sure these dogs know only love and comfort. This year, we said goodbye to 11 Forever Foster angels including Jaxson, Somreth, Diamond, Abe, Angel, Stevie Wonder, Scarlett, Venus, Cousteau, Rose and BJ.
- We also said goodbye to 17 other dogs including one of our hardest losses, Ophelia and her 10 puppies. Leonidas, her only surviving puppy, is now a Forever Foster due to his complicated medical needs that are a result of the challenges he faced as a neonate and newborn.
