MORNE PELE SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION IS MOVING FORWARD!

When people ask me what I am doing now that I have retired from the school system here in the States and I tell them that I am building a school for underprivileged children in Haiti, they look at me as if I am crazy. Why would you want to go there? Haiti is just not a friendly place for anyone. Things have progressively gotten worst in every way. I listen and I give a nervous smile. In my heart I know God sometimes ask some things that doesn't seem practical in the **natural**, but His ways are not our ways. Jeremiah had faith in God **and obeyed** though he may not have understood. I don't need to know how it will work but I need to obey the voice of God. I trust in His protection and His provision. As children of God, we obey

Him and trust Him even when we don't **understand**, and things **don't** make sense to us. We know that God will not mislead us or abandon us. God often ask us to do things that are entirely not in our comfort zone and even seem to disrupt our way of life. This is His way of testing our love to Him and our obedience. It is also a way to show that we completely trust Him. Abraham was willing to sacrifice his only son that he had waited a lifetime for. Jeremiah obeyed and bought land that would be taken over by the Babylonians. In their hearts they trusted in God's plan even though they didn't understand. Many **times**, I've wondered and question my decision to go back to Haiti. It seems that evil has taken over the island to the

level of no return. But the word of God says:

Is anything too hard for me? I will surely gather them from all the lands where I banish them in my furious anger and great wrath; I will bring them back to this place and let them live in safety. They will be my people, and I will be their God. I will give them singleness of heart and action, so that they will always fear me and that all will then go well for them and for their children after them. I will make an everlasting covenant with them: I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear me, so that they will never turn away from me. I will rejoice in doing them good and will assuredly plant them in this land with all my heart and soul. **(Jeremiah 32:37-41)**
