In the last 18 months, I have lost my elder brother and two of my sisters to cancer. It has been challenging keeping up with the project while at the same time running back and forth to the hospital and doctors' offices and caring for my sister who recently passed. However, these experiences have drawn me closer to my God as I seek Him in prayer.

Reflecting on all that has happened, I am learning to trust God even more. In spite of the difficult times, we continue to make progress in Morne Pele, Haiti. God's work has not stopped. I am thankful that all three of my siblings knew the Lord and had made their peace with God. To a Christian, death is not the end but the beginning of a new journey. ***“For we know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.” (2 Corinthians 5:1-10)***
