

FOSTERING SCHOOL, FAMILY, AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Hello, my name is Marlene Felix. I am the director of Morne Pele Christian School (MPCS). MPCS was founded immediately after the devastating earthquake that took place in Haiti on January 2010 with the intent to contribute in the lives of displaced children. Nearly half of Haiti's 10 million people are younger than 18 years old. Only half of Haitian children ever attend school, and only 2% finish high school, UNICEF says. Haiti's infant mortality rate and that of death for children younger

than five are the highest in the Western Hemisphere.

We are planning a Full-Service
Community School in northern Haiti, in a region called "Morne Pele" which is near Cap-Haitian. Our goal is to provide support, health and education to underprivileged children. Our mission is to find ways and means of meeting their physical, social and spiritual, needs and reaching out to all the children with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The first floor of our mission house is ready. We are putting further work on the missionary house on hold to began construction on our school building.

The school will be able to serve about 200 students from pre-kindergarten through High School.

PROJECTS

Morne Pele Christian School proposes a multi-faceted project in education, preventive health, spirituality and social growth. Here are the components:

1.Primary Education

A program in primary-education aiming to serve the needs of the 5+ years old.

2.Secondary Education

A program in secondary education leading to the Haiti Official State Examination and Diploma (Bacc, I & II),

3. Preventive Health

A program in preventive health, including vaccination, sport, hygiene and health awareness, to all children and adults of the surrounding neighborhood.

4. Nutrition Program

A program in nutrition available to all children and students that are enrolled in the project



5. Spiritual Awareness

A program in spirituality aiming to raise the level of spiritual growth of the people of the Community of Morne Pele.
