MEMORY VERSE	"That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honor," 1 Thessalonians 4:4
BIBLE TEXT	1 Thessalonians 4:1-8

INTRODUCTION

Sanctification means separation from evil (2 Chronicles 29:5) and separation unto God (2 Corinthians 6:17). Sanctification means being made holy or purified. It is the will of God that every vessel (believer) should be sanctified (1 Thessalonians 4:3). Only sanctified vessels can be used of God (2 Timothy 2:20-21). Reviewing our text, sanctification involves:

- Pleasing God, vs.1
- Abstaining from sexual immorality, vs.3
- Knowing how to possess one's vessel, vs.4
- Abstaining from lust, vs.5
- Not living like Gentiles (unbelievers), vs.6
- Not defrauding one another, vs.6
- Absolute cleanliness, vs.7

A. HOW A VESSEL CAN BE SANCTIFIED

- By the word of God. So, meditate on the word day and night. (John 15:3, 1 Timothy 4:5, Psalm 119: 101, Joshua 1:8)
- 2. By the blood of Jesus (Hebrews 13:12; Hebrews 10:29)
- 3. By receiving a new heart (replacing the strong heart with fleshy heart). (Ezekiel 36:26)
- By preparing to purge oneself of all filthiness of the flesh and spirit. (2 Timothy 2:20-21; 2 Corinthians 7:1)
- 5. By keeping God's company and maintaining a constant fellowship with God the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24; Ephesians 5:26 and Titus 3:5)
