

Ellouise School Of Dance's Coronavirus (COVID-19) Guidelines

If your child becomes unwell during the class, **Ellouise School Of Dance** will call the parent/carer immediately to come and collect them. While your child is awaiting collection they will be kept separately from others by a distance of 2 metres. For adults who become unwell during the class, we will ask you to leave the class immediately. In an emergency **Ellouise School Of Dance** will call 999. If this occurs **Ellouise School Of Dance** will inform others who have participated in the class as we record registers with dates and times of each group in line with the NHS National Track and Trace Programme.

Dancers responsibilities:

- On arrival dancers must sanitise their hands via the provided sanitising stations.
- Dancers must appropriately dispose of any tissues used when carrying out respiratory hygiene.
- Washing of hands and the use of hand sanitiser, as per the government guidelines.

Parents responsibilities:

- Parents must drop off and pick up children outside of the building.
- To keep in contact with **Ellouise School Of Dance**, in order to make them aware of the health of their child/children.
- Maintain accurate contact details with Ellouise School Of Dance at all times, in order to enable the NHS Track and Trace Programme effectively.

Teachers responsibility:

- Must sanitise hands on arrival, departure as well as frequently throughout the class.
- Communicate with dancers regarding their health.
- Clean surfaces and toilets with appropriate disinfectant materials, before and after each session.
- Any equipment used will be wiped down using appropriate disinfectant materials before and after each use.
