



#### **Message from the Pastor**

## Jiggle the Wire

In my college years, money was scarce. Whose funds weren't? My car reflected my financial condition. Sadlooking, more rust than metal, needing constant help. But it ran, and that's all that counted. My car was like me: not pretty but dependable. A good-old '67 Dodge Dart.

Unlike my next-door neighbor's car. She was about my age, but my opposite. She was pretty, but not dependable. She had a car given to her by a relative—who was gonna junk it till she begged him for it. It barely ran; but only if it weren't too cold, or too wet, or too hot. You get the picture.



One day her car wouldn't start in her driveway. So she asked me to help. I opened the hood. "Just jiggle the wire" she repeated her mantra.

of sorts—and the car would start. This happened so often

that 'Jiggle the Wire' was almost her nickname.

Well, I did—and the negative ground wire to the battery came off right in my hand! I told her I would go and get some tools and take care of it for good. "Oh don't bother. Just jiggle the wire." she said. "No", I replied, "It will just take me five minutes to fix it for good." She wanted to continue with the jiggling, but I insisted. Five minutes later, her car had a solid connection—no jiggling needed.

I thought, how many people treat their relationship with Jesus the same way. When they run into trouble (their lives won't start), they try to jiggle the Jesus wire. Just a quick connection so they can get where they want to go. Then, when another issue comes up and they can't help themselves, it's time to jiggle the wire again.

How much they need a permanent and solid connection to the Lord. It's like Jesus said in John 15, "I am the vine and you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit. Apart from me you can do nothing."

But for too many, it's too much effort or bother or they're too busy or whatever, but there is no lasting relationship with our Lord. Just jiggle the wire. I'll fix it later—which is often never. What a waste!

How would you describe your relationship with Jesus? A firm connection; hit and miss; just holding on? What do you want it to be?! What should it be?! God invites us to have a firm connection with him: every Sunday in worship; every time we open the Bible; every moment in prayer. Let me help you make a lasting connection with Jesus. Be there every Sunday at 10:00 and in Bible Class. You'll be glad you did.

Often, we take our cars for granted, don't we? The same is true with Jesus. We expect both to be there when we need them. However, if we don't take care of either, what happens? There's a breakdown. Fortunately, God is always ready to 'reconnect' with us. Don't just 'Jiggle the Wire'.

# Something to Think About ......Humbly Self-aware

Satan just cannot abide Christians walking peacefully and happily along the middle of the road of our lives. He will either try to shove us or shame us or intimidate us into sliding off into the ditch of insecurity, despair, and depression on one side. Or he will lure and flatter and entice us into the other ditch where smugness, arrogance, and pride rule. He loves it when we attempt to make ourselves look bigger by making other people look smaller.

The ancient Greeks used to say "Know yourself." Easy to say; hard to do. How can we cut through the fog of Satan's lies and the deception of our slick and sick culture? How do we pierce the fog of our own strong tendency to self-deception and actually accurately assess ourselves? "By the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you" (Romans 12:3).

God has given us several important gifts in self-understanding. One is his Word and the faith in our hearts that listens to and trusts that Word. The Bible is a corrective word when we are wrong and weak and a commending word when we are aligned with God's ways. Another is our family. Who better has the confidence to tell us when we're out of line? You generally can't go wrong when you make other people feel important.


