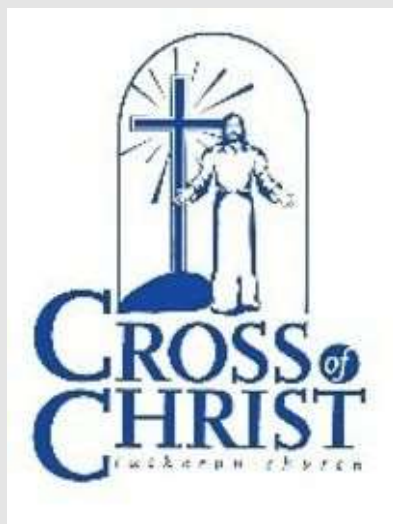

Stand up and Be Counted

Agree or Disagree? If you can't do something great, do nothing at all. The crew of a B-17 in WWII would surely disagree. On one mission, flak hit the gas tanks, but the plane did not explode. The morning after the raid, the pilot asked for the shell to keep as a souvenir. They found that not just one but six shells hit the gas tanks and five more hit the plane, but none exploded. The shells were opened but none had explosive charges in them. They were empty except one which contained a note in Polish. Translated, it read: "This is all we can do for now. God go with you."

A courageous forced laborer was disarming the German shells. He couldn't end the war, but he could save some planes. He could do something. So, he did it.

God does big things with small deeds. Against a nine-foot giant, a brook pebble seems useless. But God used it in David's sling to topple Goliath... Compared to the tithes of the wealthy, a widow's coins seem puny. But Jesus used them to inspire us... 12 disciples didn't seem like much but Jesus told them to "make disciples of all nations".

A conscience-stricken monk in Germany seemed like an annoyance at best. But God used Luther to lead millions back to the Bible and to Jesus in a movement called the Reformation.

An itinerant teacher from Podunk Nazareth seemed nothing. He had no army; wrote no best seller (although his followers did); was no political mover-and-shaker. What was he? He was the Savior of every single person who's ever drawn a breath. The homeless child of Bethlehem owns the Heavens and Earth. The one who was not important to the Romans has more followers than anyone else ever had.

Every one of the people mentioned above was willing to 'Stand Up and Be Counted'. How can you do that? Follow the Lord. Be in the Word and in Worship. Regularly. Live your life as the 10 commandments direct you. Do what is right, not what is easy. When the Holy Spirit leads you to faith through hearing the Word, when you are led to stand up, God smiles. Does God care about little ol' you? You bet-your-boots he does. He counted you and counts on you.

Something to Think About Mentally Ship-shape?

Is your thinking accurate? One way to evaluate is to ask what lies we're guilty of believing. Chris Thurman in his book 'The Lies we Believe' explains this concept. "Your brain is like a tape deck (remember them?). It can both record and play back. It has access to a personal library of thousands of tapes, ready to play at a moment's notice. These tapes hold all the beliefs, attitudes and expectations that you have 'recorded' during your life.

Some of these tapes in your brain are truthful. Like, "You can't please everyone" or "You reap what you sow". Many however, are lies. Like, "It's easier to avoid problems than to face them" or "Things have to go my way for me to be happy" or "I'm a good person so God is pleased with me".

Many of the lies you tell yourself have been repeated so often that they actually seem to be true even if they aren't. The more frequent and personally beneficial, the more deeply you believe the lie. They can even play in your mind without you realizing it.

The challenge in living our lives in a Godly way is to make our mental tapes truthful. Then a person has emotional health, close relationships, a deep sense of purpose and best of all, a real relationship with the Lord. Thoughts produce after their own kind. Lies produce death; truth produces life."

When we recognize the truth that we are lost without Jesus because of our sins, and that He is the only way to be saved, we possess the greatest truth of all. The father of lies, Satan, wants us to think we are the have all, be all, end all of our lives. Adam and Eve fell for that. And we know how that turned out.

Thurman wants us to know and live the truth. Then we have the joy, not of being right, but of being redeemed. Then our identity is wrapped up, not in the praise of people, but in the declaration of God's forgiveness.

When we are living in the truth that I have all I need in Jesus, I can live the rest of my life with openness and a joy that can't be taken away. If all our sins and weaknesses and failures have been fully covered by the blood of Jesus, then we live in the truth and are mentally ship-shape.
