

Message from Pastor A REAL LEADER

What was feared, is now reality. On February 24TH, the world watched as Russia invaded neighboring Ukraine. As we debate what can or can't be done to help, leaders throughout the world exhibit all manner of leadership skills, or lack thereof.

Vladimir Putin looks petty, isolated, haughty and downright Hitler-esq. He wants to be a big man—when all he does makes himself look small.

Volodymyr Zelenskyy, the Ukrainian president, is just the opposite. He is being hailed by the world as an amazing leader. He loves his people and country. He shows amazing courage. He is undaunted in the face of overwhelming odds. An example of that was the conversation he had with President Biden. When asked if he would like American help to leave the capital city of Kiev, he replied, "Mr. President, I need ammunition, not a ride." Contrast that with the many leaders who've taken the money and run–poor excuses for leadership.

It's not surprising that the Ukrainian people love their great leader, President Z. Before the war started, with Russian troops amassing on his border, President Z not only visited his troops in the region to boost their spirits and to encourage them. But he also ate with them. He slept in the same barracks. He wore the same army fatigues. In short, he became one of them. That idea of becoming one of them, is what real leadership looks like.

For you and I as Christians, we can't overlook the best example of real leadership that the world has ever seen – our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Among all the positive attributes of a leader we could ascribe to Jesus, the one which may mean the most to us, is that he became one of us too! **Heb. 2:14** *Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death – that is, the devil.* As we know through the pages of the Bible, Jesus became fully human. Jesus never even had to come to earth, yet he was born by human birth (in a stable, no less). He grew through boyhood into manhood. He ate. He slept. He got tired. He wept. He loved. He was tempted. He suffered. He died for us. He could have averted the "world's dirtiest job"—but didn't!

Thankfully, he chose to carry out the Father's plan. Without it, we would still be lost in our terminal condition – condemned to the Devil's domain. Why would anybody do that? Because of another characteristic of real leaders Jesus had – love for their people. Jesus couldn't bear the thought of being separated from you and me for eternity. Even though it meant becoming



a lowly human being, suffering, and dying, he loved us that much, by taking our place. He then rose from the dead to conquer death, sin and Satan; to give us a mansion in Heaven through faith in Him.

Please pray for the people of Ukraine. Pray for their heroic leader. Pray for the courageous men and women who are willing to die for their freedom. Pray for the spiritual well-being of everyone involved. Pray for Peace. Last, and most of all, thank Jesus for being a real leader of his people! President Z hasn't died for his people. Even if he had, it would be a mere tragedy. Jesus did die for us—that's salvation. What a leader!


