TYPICAL ACTIVE INGREDIENTS ALLOWED CAN INCLUDE: Acetic acid (VINEGAR), Citric acid, d-limonene (citrus oil), Clove Oil or Clove Leaf Oil, Cinnamon Oil, Lemon grass Oil, Eugenol, 2-Phenethyl Propionate, Sodium Lauryl Sulfate, Ammonium Nonanoate, Pelargonic Acid + Fatty Acids

TYPICAL ACTIVE INGREDIENTS ALLOWED CAN INCLUDE: citric acid, D-Limonene, Essential oils (including cedar, rosemary, peppermint, clove/cinnamon), soybean oil, cottonseed oil, neem oil, horticultural oil, Iron phosphate, Potassium salt of fatty acids, Diatomaceous earth, Bacillus Thuringiensis, spinosad.

Note on Mosquitoes: You can order Dragonfly larva from the Town of Wells in early spring, as one option for mosquitoes!
