



DISABLED VETERANS' Parks Pass



Broward County residents who served in the United States Armed Forces and suffer from a service-related disability can apply for a free annual parks pass.

With an annual pass, eligible veterans will never have to worry about paying the \$3.00-per-vehicle (eight or few occupants) gate entrance fee that's in effect on weekends and County holidays at most of our regional parks. The credit card-style passports will be good for five years from the date of activation – a savings of more than \$150 – and may be renewed. (The annual pass does not provide prepaid parking at Hollywood North Beach Park or admittance into special amenities or events.)



To determine eligibility, Broward County resident veterans can follow these simple steps:

1. Call to schedule an appointment at one of the six Broward County Veterans Services locations to complete an application to determine eligibility.

2. Broward County Parks and Recreation Division will contact veterans once eligibility is confirmed.

3. The eligible veteran can choose to pick up their free annual parks pass at the regional park office of their choice, or ask that to have it mailed. (If picking up a annual pass at a regional park office on a weekend or a County holiday, the \$3.00/vehicle gate fee will be in effect. Present the gate receipt that day at the park office and you will receive not only your free annual pass but a refund of the gate fee.)

Sign the back of your card and start enjoying your time at a Broward County park!
