- 1 Stainless Steel Stiffener Bracket (C800 model only)

Note: Installation will require <u>either</u> the 5/16" elevator bolt <u>or</u> the 5/16" carriage bolt so only one set of washers and one nut are provided for these 2 bolts.

Shown below is the basic installation into an existing hole in your equipment without the need for either mounting bracket. Install the elevator bolt from the inside. (Using the elevator bolt instead of the carriage bolt will help to maintain a flatter bottom in the beverage holder area.) Add flat washer, lock washer and nut on bottom of bolt.



Installation using the offset bracket (ex: flat monitor rail or round mounting bar): Install the 5/16" elevator bolt as shown in Figure 1.

Note: offset bracket can be mounted with offset either up or down (up shown).



If mounting to a flat rail install the 5/16" bolt from the top and add washers and nut as needed.



If mounting to a round rail use the $\mbox{\it \%}''$ U-bolts as shown. Add washers and nuts as needed.



If you are using the small L-bracket - install the 5/16" elevator bolt as shown in Figure 1. Then bolt the bracket to your equipment as needed using the 5/16" hex bolt, washers and nut.



Or the L-bracket can be mounted to the square hole in the back using the 5/16" carriage bolt as shown below:



<u>C800 Model Only</u>: If mounting the Cell Defender utilizing the rear mtg. hole install stiffener inside of cup holder as shown below – then insert the carriage bolt from inside as shown in figure 6.


