

Hearing Testimony:


My name is Roy Oliveira, and I am the President of Waiehu Kou Phase 3 (WKP3), a Hawaiian Home Lands (HHL) Homestead near proposed AT&T Telecommunications Facility location.



Some of the other HHL Phases as I am, are concerned with the uncompromising attitude of AT&T in its *subordination* of our concerns for this, as yet unproven safety record of their 5G technology in such close proximity to our Hawaiian people. I wish to present a timeline outlining the reverberation this has caused in my community.

1. WKP1 started this probe (2/8/21 Andrea Kaio email to Mona Kapaku DHHL Outer Island Supervisor) into the location of this cell tower, soon after this initial contact WKP1 resident and Maui Island HHL Commissioner contacted me as he began to inquire about safety risks associated with this 5G technology.
2. WKP2 started their petition of Homesteaders and interested persons on 2/14/21 seeking to tap into their community mana'o (petition link: <http://chnq.it/TkD5Yv4F>) and its views regarding this issue. Out of close to 200 response, 95% seeking AT&T relocate tower further mauka in areas of less population density in order to mitigate human exposure and radiation risk.
3. I began a survey of Waiehu Kou 3 Homestead lessees on our community web site 2/15/21 in order to determine the mana'o of our neighborhood, (link to web page that surveys and examines this issue [Cell Tower Info | Waiehu Kou Phase 3.](#)) The placing of a tower near our Homesteads was 90% negative, wanting relocation to less populated area presenting less human contact with cell tower emitted radiation. The full context

of the data available can only be appreciated if viewed in a comprehensive presentation. The AT&T narrative I was introduced to by Mr. Andrew Tomlinson of AT&T is suspect, he stated, "the **totality of the available scientific evidence** continues to **not support**

adverse health effects in humans caused by exposures at or under the current radiofrequency energy exposure limits.

This rings of a statement with *the least credibility*, this statement says, as I interpreted it, “the entirety, all evidence concludes, and existing technical data confirms no risk to support radioactive to humans at current FCC exposure rates is dangerous.

This assumption 5G poses no risk because presently you can not point to any, this is a crap shoot, that the Hawaiian Homesteads are *forced* to gamble with the health of their families.

We as the indigenous people of Maui would appreciate our elected officials help in this effort to persuade AT&T to seek a site further mauka, and where the impact to human’s health is of less consequence.
