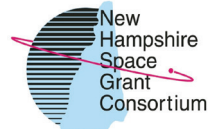
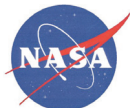

Hayley has been interested in the weather since she was a young child. She often would spend hours in front of the family camcorder with a large map pointing out the next big nor'easter bearing down on New England!

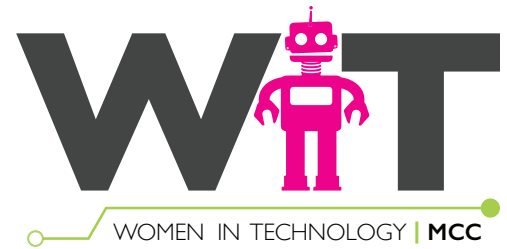
When she's not forecasting, Hayley enjoys spending time with her husband (who's a meteorologist, too), young daughter and walking her Westie named Doppler.
