

CONFESSION OF FAMILY SINS AND INIQUITIES

PRAYER

Almighty God, by an act of my will, I take back the ground in my family that my forefathers turned over to darkness. We did not fear You. We did not enter into covenant with You. We did not walk in Your commandments. I ask that my prayers for my family be in agreement with the prayers of my bloodlines in the great cloud of witnesses. I know that if I confess my sins, You are faithful and just to forgive me of my sins and cleanse me from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). I come to confess my bloodlines' and my sins, iniquities, and treachery against God and man. Before the Just Judge of the Universe, I plead my case for the removal of the legal grounds, which Satan has used to hinder the fullness of my covenant with You. I confess the sins, iniquities, and treachery of my family now.

(Using the list on previous pages, begin confessing those besetting sins, iniquities, and treacheries that the Lord has shown you about your family.)

Father, I thank You for forgiving my forefathers' and my own sins and iniquities by the blood of Jesus Christ. I am so grateful that I can come with boldness to present my petitions before You. I am so grateful that Jesus ever lives to make intercession for me. Jesus became sin so that I could become the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. On the cross, He destroyed every barrier that separated me from You. He put to death all the defilement in my body, soul, and spirit that made me Your enemy. Now, I am Your friend. I know that You hear me and that You are faithful and just to remove the legal barriers that have separated me from Your blessings.

Praise to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, who made a way for me to be a part of the family of God! I rejoice in the cross where Jesus Christ disarmed and utterly stripped the rulers and powers of darkness of their authority over my family. Jesus made a public display of them in a triumphant parade of His power and authority. Today, I am putting the powers of darkness in remembrance of their humiliation. I have come to the triumph of My Lord Jesus Christ (Colossians 2:15). On that day, I was delivered from the dominion of darkness and transferred into the kingdom of Your Beloved Son, in whom I have redemption and the forgiveness of all of my sins by the Blood of the Lamb (Colossians 1:13). Even when I was dead in my transgressions and the uncircumcision of my flesh, You made me alive together with Jesus, Your Beloved Son, having forgiven all of my transgressions.

By this confession, I am no longer a stranger alienated from you, Father, but a fellow citizen with the saints. I am a son of the Most High God! I am in the Beloved. I am a living stone in the temple of God. Today, I appropriate the finished work of the cross! Father, it was Your good pleasure to make peace with me through the cross. I have been reconciled to You through Jesus Christ's death, that I might be presented holy and blameless and beyond reproach before You.
