The mating log tab is the master list of all breeding attempts. This spreadsheet ONLY displays Ladies and Studs that are Active (i.e. NOT Retired) as well as tracks/logs all information related to the romantic get-aways, payments, attempts, and heat cycle


Information on this tab includes:

- Parents (Lady & Stud)
- Heat Cycle Start Date
- Breeding Dates & Attempts

- Paying a Stud Fee Expense
- Receiving a Stud Fee Payment

Entering a Romantic Get-Away:

- 1. Navigate to the "Mating Log (Enter Lady & Studs Romantic Get-Aways)"
- 2. Enter the Parents & use Type of the Stud
 - a. Enter the Lady that is being used in this specific romantic get-away
 - b. Enter the Stud that is being used in this specific romantic get-away
 - c. Is the stud being used for SSH Breeding or is the Stud Mingling Elsewhere?




3. Enter Information Related to the Romantic Get-Away

a. Hover over "Mating Details" in field D4

NOTE: A pop-up will appear

- **b.** Select the Hyperlink
- c. Enter the "Heat Cycle Start Date"
- d. Enter any additional notes necessary

- e. Enter the "Breeding Start Date"
- f. Enter the "Breeding End Date"
- g. Enter the # of Attempts Bred

4. Managing the Stud Fee (Expense)

- a. Hover over the "Outside Stud Fee" in field D5
- b. Select the Hyperlink
- c. Enter any additional fees requested from the Outside Stud's Owner
- d. Enter Additional Fees Paid to the Outside Stud's Owner
- e. Enter the Total \$-value Paid to the Stud's Owner (Excluding additional Fees)

Status: "N/A" -> Not Applicable

"Send Payments" -> Pay the Outside Stud Fee (Estimated > Total Paid)

"Paid in Full" -> Client/Breeder fully paid for your stud's services (i.e. Estimated Payment=Total Paid)

"Overpaid" -> Client/Breeder overpaid for your stud's services (Estimated < Total Paid)



5. Managing the Stud Fee (Income)

- a. Hover over the "Receiving Payments" in field D6
- **b.** Select the Hyperlink
- c. Enter any additional fees the Customer needs to pay
- d. Enter the Total \$-value received by the Customer

NOTE: The "Total Received for Stud Service" is calculated at the top of the section

CRITICAL: "External" being set in the "External Breeding" column populates this section if the stud is owned by SSH.

STATUS: "N/A" -> Not Applicable

"Waiting on Payments" -> Client/Breeder still needs to pay for your stud's services (Estimated > Received)

"Paid in Full" -> Client/Breeder fully paid for your stud's services (i.e. Estimated Payment = Total Received)

"Refund" -> Client/Breeder overpaid for your stud's services (Estimated < Received)
