WE'RE BREAKING FALLOW GROUND.

- Fallow means inactive or dormant.
- It is your heart that has been hardened.
- We need to break ground for fertile soil.
- Clear away what's hindering your relationship with the Creator.
- We must prepare the way for the Eternal's presence in our lives.
- We must open our lives bare before His righteous spirit.
- Your visions, hopes, and dreams won't come forth until you consider your relationship with the Most High.
- You develop spiritual cataracts by ignoring what hasn't been yielded to the Eternal on your journey.
- There must be a gentle examination of your hearts.
- When we are fallow, we are in bed with what is contrary to the Eternal and His will for us.



WHAT MUST BREAK IN THE FALLOW GROUND TO RECEIVE WHAT IS PROMISED.

- Once you recognize what lies hard in your heart, you must be ready for what is coming to eradicate it.
- Align your heart with the mission of the Eternal.
- The ground won't break until you get a tool strong enough to turn it over, and your heart won't change until you allow the Holy Spirit to do so.
- You must command your attention to what is unyielded and examine where you are in the spirit.
- When you accept the Holy Spirit, it will strip you from those things hardening your heart.
- There is a root handed to those whose hearts are transformed, and that root bears the potential to bring prosperity.
- Open your boundaries, because we cannot limit what's next for our journey.
- Break and be renewed; break and be revived; break and be transformed.
- Growth and comfort cannot coexist.
- We serve a God that possesses the fullness of the earth, yet He seeks out a relationship with you.
- Oh, to be wanted by the Eternal!



SHOW UP, STRETCH AND RUN!

- Pinchas didn't just remove the plague; he removed what was keeping Israel from a good future.
- If you scatter the seed on fallow ground, the seed isn't the issue.
- Stop asking for more seed when the Creator is trying to soften the ground for you.
- How do you know your ground is fallow?
- Israel became complacent; prayer became tradition, and conviction became an inconvenience.
- You can't be excited for the outcome without the process.
- Sometimes, when you see a detour, you get upset, so take heed and read the signs that the Most High gives to you.
- The Most High is breaking ground for a new generation.
- You must go through to get through.
- Show up, stretch, and run.
- Young people, get ready to accept the baton.
- Get in position to receive the work of the Most High.
- Take hold of the word of the Eternal.

SPIRITUAL BENEFITS OF BREAKING GROUND

- **Renewed Spirit** : When you take the time to break the fallow ground in your spirit, you open the door to divine renewal. "Remember the Sabbath, to keep it holy" (Exodus 20:8-11). It's in that sacred rest that God pours His Spirit into you, refreshing your soul.
- **Divine Connection** : In the stillness, we hear His voice. "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10). When we break away from the noise, we cultivate an intimacy with our Creator that empowers us to rise.



SPIRITUAL DRAWBACKS OF OVER TILLING

- **Spiritual Fatigue** : Overworking our spirits leads to burnout, exhausting our passion for His purpose. "To everything, there is a season" (Ecclesiastes 3:1). Embrace the seasons of rest, or you risk losing the fire of your calling.

MENTAL BENEFITS OF BREAKING GROUND

- **Diminished Impact** : Remember, relentless pursuit may seem noble, but "all is vanity" (Ecclesiastes 1:2). Work smarter, not harder. Break the fallow ground to allow for true growth and significant impact in your life and the lives of others.



EMOTIONAL BENEFITS OF BREAKING GROUND

- **Healing and Restoration** : When we take time to break the fallow ground of our hearts, we create space for healing. "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds" (Psalm 147:3). Rest allows God to mend our emotional scars, bringing restoration to our souls.
