Life Programs— We will continue to be involved in the local 40 Days for Life March in October and our support of The Crossing of Manitowoc County. We will explore additional ways that we can be advocates and support the Right to Life movement!

Faith Programs— Faith and Family Director Jim Clark will suggest ways to expand these programs in addition to continuing to offer Masses for the L/D members of Council 710, sponsoring radio broadcasts of Mass, Keep Christ in Christmas yard signs and involvement in the Marriage Blessing events. Should we bring back the Nativity scene from years past? Will another donation for Ukrainian relief be appropriate?

Family Programs— What new programs can we start/restart to add to Knowledge Contest, Food for Family donations and the Christmas Poster contest? How about Punt/Pass/Kick, Soccer Challenge or ???.

Community Programs— We have a strong history and support of the Coats for Kids program and the Tootsie Roll Fundraiser for Intellectual Disabilities. In addition, we've supported numerous other organizations over the years and I know we remain committed to supporting these in the future. Is there more we can do?

Parish and School— Building on our historical support of our Parishes and Roncalli Catholic Schools, what more can we do? With the establishment of the Round Table at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish last year, how can we leverage this to make an impact?
