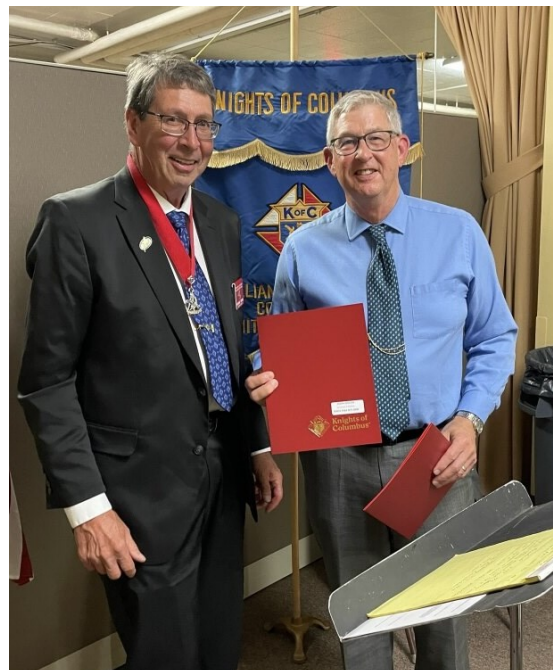
We Welcome Six New Brothers!
