Notes from the Grand Knight

Our Council continues to be very active, thanks to the efforts of many of our dedicated Brothers. A brief recap of recent events includes: (1) gifting 52 bibles to those being confirmed on January 25; (2) gifting bibles to fourth graders at Roncalli Catholic Schools; (3) taking a lead role in the World Marriage weekend events; (4) free throw competition for boys and girls ages 9-14; and (5) Knowledge contest for grades 5-8.

Charity continues at the center of what we do. At our February meeting, membership approved unanimously the following donations: (1) as part of the One by One campaign, total pledges of \$100,000 for the new Roncalli 3K-8th school and \$12,500 for St. Francis of Assisi's ministry and building initiative; (2) \$5,000 for the ultrasound fund for The Crossing; (3) \$2,500 to the St. Vincent DePaul food pantry; and (4) \$500 for the upcoming Shamrocks for Shelter event benefiting The Haven's impactful programs.

Looking ahead, we have many things to plan for in addition to the dates noted on page one: (1) April 28 & 29—brat fry in conjunction with the St. Clare Society rummage sale; (2) May 5-7—Tootsie Roll fundraiser; (3) May 16—concession stand at resource fair at Expo sponsored by ADRC; (4) July 11—Mass in the Park; (5) July 14-16—Wisconsin Sand Sculpting Festival; and (6) August 11-13—St. Francis of Assisi Parish picnic.
