MARIPOSAS DE CHILE – BUTTERFLIES OF CHILE

by P. Peña and Ugarte. 1997. 288pp (full color), paper.
Edit. Universitaria, Santiago, Chile. Import price: \$45.00 paper (Flora & Fauna Books).

This excellent book provides a modern identification guide and field book for all 169 butterfly species known for Chile. The fauna of Chile is completely isolated from the forest butterflies of tropical South America, and has only a few species in common with southern Argentina. Each species is illustrated with a color painting (there are occasional photographs taken in nature), plus a color habitat photograph and a distribution map. The text is in both Spanish and English throughout.

BUTTERFLIES OF GREECE

by L. N. Pamperis. 1997. 574pp, cloth.
Bastas-Plessas Publ., Athens, Greece. Price: 30,000 Dr. (about US\$103, with S/H).
This first comprehensive book on the butterflies of Greece gives coverage for all 232 species known for the region. The book includes 1,174 color photographs taken in nature and 123 distribution maps. The text is in English, with descriptions and notes for each species, plus the conservation status of each species. The book has 574 pp, in A4 size (ca. 8 x 11.5 inches), and is cloth bound.

LISTE SYSTÉMATIQUE ET SYNONYMIQUE DES LÉPIDOPTÈRES DE FRANCE, BELGIQUE ET CORSE (2nd ed.)

by P. J. A. Leraut. 1997. 526pp, paper.
Supplement to *Alexanor*. Paris.
A welcome 2nd edition of Leraut's well-received *Liste* of 1980, this new edition provides extensive additions and changes. The new edition has parentheses around authors of names that have been recombined in different genera (unfortunately, not for synonyms). Notes and introductory pages are in 4 languages: French, Flemish, German, and English. Over 5,100 species are treated.

BUTTERFLY GARDENING

by T. C. Emmel. 1997. 112pp, cloth (10 x 10 in).
Friedmann/Fairfax Publ., New York. Price: \$19.95.
This large format book covers all details of butterfly gardening, but is particularly interesting from the Lepidopterist's viewpoint in having a 50-page summary of the commoner North American butterfly species. All illustrations are full color, with figures on virtually every page.

All families of Lepidoptera are covered, giving a synopsis of the morphology, economic species, distribution, life history, and important references for each family. There will be a large bibliography to the world literature on the Lepidoptera, with sections on faunal literature, plus taxonomic papers arranged by family. The planned supplement (Suppl. 3 of *Tropical Lepidoptera* Vol. 4, 1993 [1996]) is only the key to families (\$7.50 for ATL members).

LEPIDOPTERORUM CATALOGUS (New Series)

edited by J. B. Heppner

The new series began in 1989 with the publication of Fasc. 118 Noctuidae (Poole) [now 124], after a 50 year interlude since the original series ended in 1939. In 1996, Fasc. 48: Epermeniidae (by R. Gaedike) was published. In 1997, Fasc. 55: Acrolepiidae (by R. Gaedike) was published so far, and Fasc. 7: Neopseustidae (D. R. Davis) and Fasc. 62: Oxychirotidae (J. B. Heppner) are expected before the end of December.

In 1998, we expect the following families to be completed: Prototheoridae, Ochsenheimeriidae, Glyphipterigidae, Brachodidae, Lacturidae, Ratardidae, Hedyliidae, Oxytenidae, Cercophanidae, and others. Some families announced for 1997 had to be postponed due to pending research that will result in added species descriptions.

Member prices are nominal (\$1.50 to \$4.50 each), depending on size; non-member prices are \$4.50 to 7.50 each. Larger parts will be higher priced.
